



My brothers,

I write this while on a directed retreat (silent) from the Jesuit's Eastern Point Retreat House. Located on the coast just north of Boston, it is the perfect place for prayer and reflection. I'm blessed with an amazing spiritual director and the Lord speaks clearly to me through His Word and Sacrament as well as in the crashing of the waves, the song of the gulls, and the play of the harbor seals! This is the second year I've come here and God willing. I will return next year! I highly recommend that each and every one of you make an annual retreat at a Catholic retreat center either alone or with your spouse or a spiritual friend. It will change your life! If you are looking for good places to go on retreat, ask me or any one of our priests or deacons. We are here for you!

On September 29th, we celebrated the Feast of the Holy Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael and a few days later, on October 2nd we celebrate the Feast of the Guardian Angels. Sacred Scripture and the Tradition of the Church speak of the existence and activity of the angels in the world. They are "messengers" of God, announcing God's saving plan and protecting His people from physical and spiritual dangers.

I have a special devotion to the Angels. I believe that each day we are engaged in a spiritual combat. I depend on the Holy Angels to guide and protect me along the way. St. Michael is extremely powerful and I "arm myself" with his prayer each day.

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; And do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan and all evil spirits who wander through the world for the ruin of souls.

This is one of the prayers from the Rite of Exorcism. I pray this prayer with all my being and with a full act of will. I then name my demons. I begin with the 7 capital sins and then continue with my current temptations.

Afterwards, I am mindful of Jesus' warning that when we expel one demon, he will return with seven others (Mt 12:43–45). So immediately after expelling the demons with the St. Michael prayer, I ask my Guardian Angel to protect me!

Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here, ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen.

We each have a Guardian Angel. So does our family, our Council, our parish, and our Church! Our Guardian Angels are powerful friends who guide and protect us. They assist us in every way. We can even "send" them to help others in need. But like GPS, they can do little good if we are not attentive to them!

This month of October, let's pray to the Holy Angels for guidance and protection. Let us also ask them to intercede for us as we prepare for our Oktoberfest on the 13th! May it be a celebration of peace and joy for all!
